Hertfordshire FA Sunday Junior Cup Final

Hertfordshire Athletic completed the second part of what could be a cup and league treble. Having the clinched the domestic Intermediate Cup final seven days before, they came through an epic clash in the all WSL affair with Woodside at the County ground Letchworth on Sunday afternoon. The two well matched teams who have dominated the WSL Second division all season where locked together at 2-2 at the end of normal time, before only being separated 3-2 after a dramatic penalty shoot-out and inflicting on Woodside a second shoot-out defeat in this competition in four seasons.

Woodside whose sixteen-man final squad contained seven survivors from that defeat three years ago went ahead after thirty-two minutes when Tom Garratt thumped the ball home at the second attempt after an initial save from Thomas West. That lead only lasted seven minutes after Evan King slipped in Jack McLaughlin who raced clear and slotted past Simon Ross. Then in the first minute of added on time at the end of the first half, Jack McLaughlin saw his goal bound effort superbly tipped over by Ross, but from the resulting corner Henry Gibbor managed to nod the ball on from James Hicks who smashed the ball home to give Athletic the lead.

The second half played in heavy driving rain saw Woodside twice strike the bar from long range, although Athletics' pattern of play was disrupted by injures and where forced to make a flurry of subs, they always looked dangerous on the counter attack with Jack McLaughlin a constant threat. Despite the changes and thanks to some resolute defending they looked to of held on until the fifth minute of added on time, when Woodside forced a corner, they sent up keeper Simon Ross who helped to cause total chaos in the six-yard box, and a massive goal line scramble finally ended with Joe McCarthy firing the home the equaliser.

If the final minutes of added on time where dramatic then it was nothing compared to the high drama in the penalty shoot-out which followed. Athletic went first, but Jack McLaughlin sent his effort against the foot of the left-hand post. Ellis Constantinou then netted for Woodside and then the shoot-out seemingly turned in Woodside's favour when Edward Rogers missed. But the next kick saw Woodside miss themselves with Josh Towle seeing his effort saved by Thomas West. The next three kicks, two for Athletic either side of a Woodside kick, where all converted before Woodside's Joe Fox saw his effort saved once again by West. Christian Frater's kick for Athletic then swung the shoot-out back in his teams' favour, leaving Liam Grosso having to needing to score to take it to sudden death, but once again West guessed correctly and saved it to seal the victory.

Nothing should be taken away from Woodside who played their part in a great advertisement for the WSL.

Terry Deveruex Presidents Cup Final

St Joseph's won the competition for a third consecutive time, in this final held over from last season as they defeated a hardworking Evergreen team 3-1.

It was the reigning holders who had a dream start when they went in front after just two minutes, when Owen Deamer ran clear through the Evergreen defence who seemed to freeze, and slotted home past Luke Simpson. Evergreen slowly worked their back into the game and missed a great chance to level the scores after twenty minutes, when a neat passing move played in Jake Sahota but he fired over when he looked almost certain to equalise, and they where left to rue that chance when five minutes later veteran striker Lewis Putman scored a fine goal to double Joes lead, when turned with his back to the goal before firing a curled effort into the left hand corner of the net following a passing move which had pulled the Evergreen defence apart.

Ten minutes later Tom Verbana gave Evergreen some real hope when he flicked the ball home from close range following a free-kick from the right-hand side, and just two minutes later Caden Barber whose excellent performance was enough to reward him with the man of the match award cleared off the line. Two minutes after that Harry Seabrook made it 3-1 with a fine downward header.

The second half failed to live up to the quality of the first, with neither side creating much, indeed the only shot of the entire half of note came in the fourth minute of added on time when Evergreen substitute Steve Wilson saw his shot tipped away by Lewis Everett in the Joes goal.

United picked up where they left off in the second half with Vethurshan Sellathurai finishing a well worked move. He doubled his tally for the fifth shortly after and the win was finished off by Haroon Mahmood to make it 6-0.

Everett Rovers and St Joseph's Reserves both kept alive their promotion hopes with home wins ahead of their double header on April 27th which could go a long to determine the final promotion places. Everett beat Watford Town 2-1, with all the goals coming in the first half. Harvey Mogford put Rovers ahead before Watford Town pulled back level after a cross wasn't dealt which allowed Harry Ovington to level before Lucas Roberts scored what turned out to be the winner after rounding the keeper.

Joes Reserves came through an eight-goal thriller with Watford Youth Sports 1st. They lead 2-0 at the break thanks to a solo left foot effort from Anton Collins and a header from Max Foley. In the second half Ben Sierra-Grieves and Robbie Tocher scored before Sports fighting for their lives at the wrong end of the table, staged a valiant fight back thanks to goals from Mackenzie Fookes, Stevie Dowling and Zak McNicholas despite being reduced down to ten men, but it was Ben Sierra-Grieves who rounded off the win.
