Weekly Review - 7th April - by Mark Bunn

Hertfordshire FA Intermediate Cup Final

There was no dream ending to SOCA's county run as they suffered a 5-0 defeat to Brewster Plumbing of the Berkhamsted Sunday league. On paper both sides seemed evenly matched with very similar results to reach the final and both sitting third in their respective divisions, but it was Brewster who on the day where the better team.

The pattern of the game was set as early as the sixth minute when the dangerous Curtis Donaldson raced through the SOCA defence, rounded keeper Bradley Bridges, but could only fire inches wide with the goal gapping. Three minutes Jordan Austin for SOCA, who was their best performer on the day had a chance to give his side the lead, but he fired narrowly wide from close range. The strong wind was making good football difficult for either side, but Brewster seemed to adapt better to the conditions and along with the excellent left sided midfielder Lewis Collins SOCA where being pushed back, as he saw his shot well saved by Bridges in the SOCA goal, but finally the mounting pressure told, and after twenty two minutes Curtis Donaldson raced onto a ball over the top and finished well to give his team the lead. SOCA thought they had brought themselves level soon after but Jordan Austin's goal was ruled out for offside. Six minutes before the break, Donaldson doubled his sides lead with his second, when his corner from the right helped by the wind curled all the way into the opposite side of the goal without anyone touching it.

Despite making a substitution at half time, and two further subs in the opening eleven minutes of the half, the game was effectively over twelve minutes into the second period when Donaldson completed his hat trick, when slotted home a rebound after Bridges could only block Lewis Collins first effort with his legs into his path and he made no mistake. Collins who was at times unplayable, scored the best goal of the afternoon when after switching wings he turned up on the right side raced through, beat two defenders and slotted home into the bottom corner. A minute later Jordan Austin struck the crossbar for SOCA with a long range effort, and two minutes later Brewster had Lewis Swindells sent off with a second yellow card. In the first minute of the five added on at the end, the rout was complete when sub lanis Coira scored a penalty after being brought down by Calvin Monaghan again for a second yellow, after being booked in the earlier confrontation win in which Swindells had been dismissed.

Premier Division

St Josephs gained six points from their double header with FC Unicorn 2-0 and 7-1, to move themselves into fourth place in the table, although twenty one points behind leaders North Watford, although they do have six games in hand.

Nick Kerley and Dan Griggs sealed the win in the first game with two goals in the opening half. In the second game Joes took apart the Unicorn defence at will scoring seven times, with Nick Kerley netting four times, along with Dan Griggs. Jake Swaine, and Liam Smyth, with Brett Parkins scoring the Unicorn reply.

Evergreen are in third place as they beat local rivals Abbots Langley Club 4-0, with all the goals coming in the second. Two almost identical goals from Tom Verbana followed, he also missed a chance for a hatrick seeing his penalty saved but Jake Sahota turned in the rebound. The final goal came when a corner was headed in by Max Sahota.

Division One

For the second week running the top two Chalfont Saints and Watford Sports clashed, and following a 2-2 draw seven days before it was Saints who ran out 3-0 winners to open up a five point lead at the summit. An opening goal came after fifteen minutes from Sean Haugh following persistence and he finished neatly. Saints keeper Kennedy Newbert made one superb double save shortly after to keep his team ahead before Andre Ford doubled the lead just before half time with a strike from the edge of the box. In the second half Andre Ford then sealed the win in the second half after a keeper error. Watford United beat Langleybury 8-0 who will finish the season in bottom place. The goals started flowing early into the path of Adam Anwar scoring early on before adding a second slotting in the far corner. The third goal came before the break from Nitharshan Sellathurai.



The second half saw the goals continue to flow as Adam Anwar completed his hat trick, followed by a well worked finished off by Nitharshan Sellathurai. Ellis Constantinuo added the sixth from an in swinging corner. Daanyaal Anwar made it seven with a fine solo goal and Sanjef Vigneswaran rounded off the scoring as he scored the eighth from long distance.

Old Fullerians took four points from their double header with Chess United, 4-0 and 1-1, but the point gained by Chess means they will not finish in the bottom two. The first game saw all the goals scored in the second half. Jake Entwistle got down the right and cut back for Craig Totton to sweep home. Craig Totton added another soon after, Ryan Woosley squared for Totton to drill home from the edge of the box. Craig Totton then turned provider, finding Jake Entwistle to the left of the box, he rolled in to the far post past the advancing keeper. Chris Colman finished the scoring, picking the ball up on the right he found the top right corner. The return match was a far closer affair, with Fullerians taking the lead when a ball forward from Mark Needham was latched onto by Jake Entwistle who beat the keeper as he came out. Chess then saw a penalty saved, but in the second half they scored the vital equaliser to ensure first division safety when a Alfie Hewetson cross was met at the back post by Cameron Murray.

Division Two

It has been a good week for Everett Rovers as they defeated their two closest title contenders. On Wednesday evening they beat Sparta Phoenix 5-1, before beating St Joseph's Reserves 2-1. Mitchell Tearle gave Joes Reserves the lead in the first half, and they looked like inflicting on Everett a first league defeat of the season, until two very late goals. First Charlie McNally equalised and there was still time for a winner when Jordan Standley ran on to a through ball to calmly lob the goalkeeper.
